COURSES IN ENGLISH



Children's Literature in a Global Perspective

15 ECTS | AUGUST-NOVEMBER

Covers the development of children's literature and is particularly designed for teacher trainees. The course will also prove stimulating to librarian students and to undergraduates in English and comparative literature.

Children's rights

15 ECTS | NOVEMBER-JANUARY

The objective of the course is to be able to account for the content and message of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, in relation to children's participation and citizenship and by comparisons in international contexts.

Sports Psychology

15 ECTS | NOVEMBER - JANUARY

The purpose of the course is to provide the student with the basic knowledge of psychological factors and processes that influence the individual in sports. Focus is placed on a research-to-practice orientation that is used to prepare for sports performance.

Learning and Teaching in Multicultural Schools

15 ECTS | AUGUST-NOVEMBER

The aim of the course is to prepare student teachers for their professional task of teaching within the context of diversity in pre-schools and schools. The course includes a short practice period in a school/pre-school setting.

15 ECTS | NOVEMBER-JANUARY

The course is interdisciplinary and focused on Education for Sustainable Development, ESD. A main idea is to consider local and global challenges for sustainable development.

15 ECTS | AUGUST-NOVEMBER

The course gives students a theoretical and practical understanding of Physical Education (PE) and Sports in a Swedish context. "Friluftsliv", i.e. activities and learning in the natural environment, has a special role in Swedish culture, and the course focuses specifically on this and includes one week of outdoor activities.

Populism, Nationalism and History

7.5ECTS | AUGUST-NOVEMBER

Students will be introduced to nationalist and populist movements across the political spectrum to assess the way in which they attempt to legitimise their actions by viewing history through dystopian or utopian lenses. Students will gain an understanding for how history is used to legitimise these political actors' ideological ideas and values. They will also develop their ability to relate critically to these. The module is global in scope, using case studies from the Nordic countries, the Americas, sub-Saharan African and other regions.

Application process for incoming exchange students

The sending university announces their nominated exchange students to Malmö University before the application deadline (see below). Malmö University provides nominated students with application instructions, and the students apply online at <https://mau.se/en/education/apply-for-exchange-studies/>

Students apply for accommodation at the same time as they apply for their exchange.

Accepted students receive a Letter of Acceptance from Malmö University.

Exchange students are invited to participate in the introduction programme arranged by Malmö University, including a Swedish language course of 5 ECTS credits.

Application periods for incoming exchange students

- For studies in the spring semester (January–June): online application is open between September 15–October 15
- For studies in fall semester (September–January): online application is open between March 15–April 15.
